Public Service Announcement

Create a Public Service Announcement in order to inform people about an issue and challenge them to take action in order to make a difference.

Part One: Choose your issue.

- 1. What is the social issue you choose to focus on?
- List some potential ways to make the issue better or ways to make people aware of a problem.
- 3. Share your ideas with family members or friends. Get their ideas about what will help improve the issues. Incorporate the best ideas into your planning.
- 4. Reflect: Why did you select this specific issue?

Part Two: Design your PSA.

- 1. With your audience and purpose in mind, write a call to action to use for your PSA.
- 2. Conduct research and verify your sources are solid.
- 3. Draft a script and some art ideas to go with your call to action.
- 4. You may use social media, in person, or print for your medium. Gather your supplies and create your art and script.
- 5. Find a partner and rehearse PSA scripts and give your partner valuable feedback on language and images.

Part Three: Present your PSA.

- 1. Tell the whole group about your project with a brief summary of your issue, the call to action, and your strategy.
- 2. Share your PSA and ask the group to help you share it with their network.

Part Four: Reflection on the project.

- 1. What were some of the most interesting discoveries made while working on this project? About the problem? About yourself? About others?
- 2. How will I use what I've learned in the future?
