YOUR SOLUTION CAN BE AT VARIOUS SCALES.

The word, "scale", refers to whether your target of giving will be either local, state, national, or global.



- Poverty is defined as the state of having little or no money and few or no material possessions.
- Think about ways to get money and possessions to those who need it.

GOAL #1: NO POVERTY



- Everybody gets hungry. But hunger is defined as households that don't have enough food for every family member to lead a healthy life.
- Think about ways to get food to people who don't have enough to eat.

GOAL #2: ZERO HUNGER



- This means that people are free from illness, both physical and mental. It also means that people live in safe, functional, environments.
- Think about ways to help people who could have their health and well-beings improved upon.

GOAL #3: GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING



- Every child deserves a quality education. A quality education defined as a safe environment staffed by caring, and knowledgeable staff that allow children to reach their full potentials.
- Think about ways to improve the educational opportunities for children, either within your own school, or another one in need.

GOAL #4: QUALITY EDUCATION



- Gender equality means that women and men, and girls and boys, enjoy the same rights, resources, opportunities and protections.
- If you can think of situations where this equality doesn't hold true, what can you do to improve matters?

GOAL #5: GENDER EQUALITY



- Clean water is a basic human need, as well as living in sanitary conditions.
- If you know of a situation where clean water is not easily accessible, or unsanitary conditions are present, what can you do to improve matters?

GOAL #6: CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION



- Being able to have electricity and heating and cooling systems are essential to living well. It's also essential to conserve energy.
- What could you do to help conserve energy, and/or help those people who don't have access to energy.

GOAL #7: AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY



- This means that people should have jobs that are safe and able to provide them their basic needs.
- You could educate your classmates on what jobs are in demand and what is required to have such jobs. You could plan ahead to what jobs you are considering to ensure that you have decent work and economic growth.

GOAL #8: DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH



- Industries are certain fields that produce a good, or provide a service.
 Innovation is when people come up with new ideas that help. Infrastructure are the things we all use like roads, water pipes, etc.
- Focus on innovation and come up with, and implement, an idea that improves something.

GOAL #9: INDUSTRY, INNOVATION, AND INFRASTRUCTURE



- Inequality is an unfair situation when some people have more opportunities, and/or rights than other people
- Identify where you've seen inequality and come up with something that lessens it.

GOAL #10: REDUCED INEQUALITY



- Sustainable communities entails creating career and business opportunities, safe housing, and buildings.
- What can you do to make your community more sustainable and a better place to live for everyone who lives there.

GOAL #11: SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES




- Responsible consumption means using only what is needed and reuse, recycle, and reduce whenever you can. Responsible production means to run a business that doesn't pollute, or harm the community.
