John Chapman 1774 - 1845	American pioneer and folk hero known as Johnny Appleseed. He planted apple trees across the frontier from the Allegheny River to the Saint Mary River. Born September 26, 1774 in Leominster, Massachusetts.
Ben Franklin 1706 - 1790	He lived in Philadelphia and formed the first fire department.
Mt. Rushmore 1927 - 1941	National Landmark carved on a mountain in South Dakota
Clara Barton 1821 - 1912	She founded the Red Cross.
Statue of Liberty 1886	A gift from France that is a symbol of freedom and liberty.
Martin Luther King Jr. 1929 - 1968	American Civil Rights leader who advocated nonviolence to create change.
