

Foundation Poster Rubrics

Directions: Create a poster or brochure to tell others about the foundation you have chosen. Make the product attractive with color and illustrations and easy to read and understand. The final product advocates for the work of the foundation and may encourage people to learn more, donate, or apply for grants. Include the following information:

- Name of the foundation
- Date of founding
- Areas of focus, including mission statement and examples of funding interests
- Name and description of the founder, including how he/she showed good character and/or personal virtue
- Short history of the foundation

Contact information (include website) Points	Criteria
In order to receive a "4"	The product contains all six required sets of information and is neat, clear and attractive.
In order to receive a "3"	The product contains four or five required sets of information and is neat, clear and attractive.
In order to receive a "2"	The product contains three required sets of information and is neat and clear.
In order to receive a "1"	The product contains all two or less required sets of information and is neat.
No credit	The product is unclear and provides little information for the reader.
