

## Founding Document Analogy

What is an analogy?

An analogy is a comparison between things that have similar features, often used to help explain a principle or idea.

Example:

The *federal government*

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is like *a parent*

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because *it must provide protection for its people like a parent must watch out for the safety of their children. Second, it must also be fair to all its people, just like a parent should be fair to each and all their children. Finally, the federal government is like a parent because they have to be sure to treat the people they govern with respect and not abuse their power.*
