Choose five to eight questions for research or interview. Brainstorm more or edit as a class. An interview may last 15 to 20 minutes.

1. Who in your family influenced you?
2. What are some values you learned from home, school, and faith-based instruction that led you to be a philanthropist?
3. What were your home and neighborhood like when you grew up?
4. What was an incident that prompted your philanthropic passion?
5. What is your philanthropic passion (the arts, poverty, community building, etc.)? Why?
6. In what ways has the community changed over the years?
7. Is there someone you admire for their philanthropic contribution?
8. What do you hope to be remembered for years from now?
9. How do you see young people being agents of change?
